

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

TOTAL TOUR PRICE: The tour price is based on airfare, cruise, land rates and rates of exchange in effect April 10, 2006. All rates are subject to change without prior notice. Should the rates go up or down, an adjustment would be made prior to departure. No refunds can be granted for any accommodations, services or events that are not used nor if you deviate from the tour. This tour is subject to a minimum of 25 pilgrims. If fewer participate, a price adjustment may be necessary.

PASSPORT AND VISA REQUIREMENTS: A valid passport is required. At the time of printing, U.S. citizens holding valid passports DO NOT REQUIRE visas or immunization for the country or countries being visited. Citizens of countries other than U.S.- please contact the consulate of the country or countries being visited to determine visa requirements.

AIR TRANSPORTATION: International flight reservations are being held on Continental. No stopovers are permitted. Any changes after ticket is issued, carries a mandatory charge of \$200. Once the tickets are issued, they are NON REFUNDABLE. Additional non-recoverable airline penalties of up to \$100 may be assessed for cancellations received within 90 days of departure

DOMESTIC AIRFARE: For those who make domestic air arrangements to the originating city of this tour, your tour host and Unitours strongly recommend the purchase of tickets that can be changed without heavy fees and penalties as international flight schedules are always subject to change.

HOTEL ACCOMMODATIONS: Specially selected hotels based on twin occupancy with private bath are reserved. Single Room supplement of \$320 will be charged where requested and available. If you do not have a roommate and Unitours is unable to arrange one, you will be billed for the single room supplement. All singles are subject to availability.

MEALS: Breakfast and Table D' Hote dinners are provided daily except where noted in the itinerary. An extra charge will be made when coffee, tea or other beverages are not included in the menu of the day with the dinner meal.

TIPS AND TAXES: Tips and taxes normally appearing on hotel and restaurant bills as service are included, as are all government and local taxes on hotels and meals, portage of one suitcase per person. Departure taxes of \$80 plus current fuel charge of \$110 per person are included (both subject to change). Tips to Tour Manager/Guide, bus driver and dining room staff of \$58 are not included. One average sized suitcase not exceeding 50 lbs total weight and 62 linear inches (define as height plus width plus depth) is allowed throughout the trip. Hotel portage provided if hotel offers such service.

NOT INCLUDED: Expenses and items not specifically mentioned in this brochure are NOT covered, including but not limited to: passport and visa fees, meals not listed and items of a personal nature such as laundry, wines, liquors, mineral waters, after dinner coffee or tea, sightseeing or services other than those specifically mentioned, tips mentioned above, excess baggage and insurance, etc.

DEPOSITS AND CANCELLATIONS: A deposit of \$300 is required to secure reservations. Any balance is to be paid in full no later than 60 days before departure of tour. Final payments received at Unitours after 45 days before departure must include a \$25 late

payment fee. (This does not apply for new reservations made after 45 days of departure.) Reservations made within 60 days of departure must include full payment. Credit cards can be used for a fee. Cancellations made from time of reservation to within 61 days prior to departure — \$100 processing charge plus any air penalties noted above. In the event of a cancellation from 60 to 8 days of departure — \$150 processing charge plus up to 50% of the land cost, plus any air penalties noted above. There can be no refund for any services for cancellations received within 7 days of departure. All cancellation and refund claims must be in writing to Unitours, Inc.

CHANGE FEE: All changes not received in writing at least 30 days prior to departure will incur a \$35 change fee per person for each revision.

DEVIATIONS: A service charge of \$50 pp will be applied for any deviations made in tour, (where possible), PLUS any additional air or land charges incurred.

LAND ARRANGEMENTS: The tour operator reserves the right to change the itinerary due to unforeseen emergencies.

RESPONSIBILITIES: Unitours, Inc., the organizer, and their representatives act only as agents for the tour members in making arrangements for hotels, transportation, sightseeing, restaurants or any other services in connection with the itinerary. They will exercise reasonable care in making such arrangements, however, they do not assume any liability whatsoever, for any injury, damage, loss, accident or delay to person or property because of any acts of war or terrorism, any act of default of any hotel, carrier, restaurant, company or person rendering any of the services included in the tours. The tickets, coupons, tariffs, rules or contracts currently in use by any carrier, hotel, restaurant or other contractor rendering services shall constitute the sole contract between such contractor and the tour member. **Unitours Inc., or the organizer, accept no responsibility for any damage or delay due to sickness, pilferage, labor disputes, machinery breakdown, quarantine, government restraints, weather or any other cause beyond their personal control.** No carrier shall be responsible for any act, omission or events during the time passengers are not on board its own conveyance. Daily Itinerary

Monday, February 5 - Day 1 - Depart from Denver to Israel via Newark, NJ on board Continental Airlines' flights
Tuesday, February 6 - Day 2 - Arrival at Ben-Gurion Airport, Israel. Meeting, welcome and assistance by a Unitours representative. After meeting our guide and driver, we head north to our hotel in Tiberias, on the shores of the Sea of Galilee. **Dinner & Overnight: Tiberias**

Wednesday, February 7 - Day 3 - We start our sightseeing program with a panoramic view of Nazareth, Jesus boyhood town, from Mount Precipice. We enter the city and visit the Church of Annunciation and the traditional site of Mary's Well. From here we return to the Sea of Galilee area to Mount of Beatitude, where Jesus delivered his "Sermon on the Mount". End the day at Yardenit, a baptismal site on the River Jordan. **Dinner & Overnight: Tiberias**

Thursday, February 8 - Day 4 - Start the day with a visit to an ancient fishing boat, 2000 years old, fondly known as "Jesus Boat". After, we take a boat ride across the Sea of Galilee to Capernaum, the center of Jesus' Ministry, and see the ruins of an ancient synagogue. Ascend the Golan Heights and drive to Caesarea Philippi, an ancient pagan and later Christian city at the southern base of Mt. Hermon, here Peter identified Jesus as the Messiah. We return to our hotel. On the way we stop to visit Bethsaida, home of the Apostles Philip, Simon and Andrew, where Jesus fed the five thousand and healed the blind man. **Dinner & Overnight: Tiberias**

Friday, February 9 - Day 5 - Depart Tiberias driving to Beit Shean, the most monumental Roman/Byzantine city in the area. Proceed via the Jordan Valley to Bethlehem and Jerusalem. On the way we can view the ancient biblical city of Jericho, the oldest and lowest inhabited city in the world (if security will permit we will enter the city). Ascending the Judean hills, we stop for an overview of the city from Mt. Scopus. Continue to Bethlehem where we view the Shepherds Fields and visit the Church of the Nativity and Manger Square. **Dinner & Overnight: Jerusalem**

Saturday, February 10 - Day 6 - Our full day tour of Jerusalem begins at the Mount of Olives for a breathtaking view of the entire city. Walk down the traditional Palm Sunday route to the beautiful chapel of Dominus Flevit and continue to the Church of All Nations in the Garden of Gethsemane. Proceed to the Church of St. Peter in Gallicantu, considered by many as the site of the Palace of Caiaphas. End the day at Mount Zion where we visit the Room of the Last Supper. Enter the Old City and walk to the Church of the Holy Sepulcher and along part of the Via Dolorosa to the Pool of Bethesda. End the day at the Garden Tomb. **Dinner & Overnight: Jerusalem**

Sunday, February 11 - Day 7 - (Sometime today we worship with a local Christian congregation). Return to the Old City and the Jewish Quarter to visit the Temple Mount, where the Dome of the Rock is. On to the Western Wall and the Ophel - The archeological excavations at the Southern Steps that lead up to the Second Temple. The rest of the day is free to explore or rest. **Dinner & Overnight: Jerusalem**

Monday, February 12 - Day 8 - Depart Jerusalem and drive to the Qumran Caves where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered. Drive along the shores of the Dead Sea to Masada, the last stronghold of the Jews against the Romans. Ascend by cable car and tour the famed archaeological site. Drive to the Ein Gedi Oasis for some fun and relaxation and enjoy an opportunity of "floating" in the Dead Sea. Return to Jerusalem. **Dinner & Overnight: Jerusalem**

Tuesday, February 13 - Day 9 - Today is dedicated to the New City of Jerusalem driving by the Knesset (Israel's Parliament), we visit Yad Vashem Memorial to the Holocaust. Continue to Israel Museum to view the model of Jerusalem from the time of the Second Temple and an exhibition of the Dead Sea Scrolls that were found in Qumran. The rest of the day is free to rest, to catch up on shopping, or to return to sites that we already visited. We meet in the hotel for a farewell dinner. After checkout, we transfer to the airport for an overnight flight home.
